
LEVEL 3 COURSE

STRATEGIES FOR COMPLEX P2/ENGAGEMENT

This course looks at the systems we work in to map the complex interactions and influences that happen when we seek to solve difficult, high stakes, challenging problems in the midst of diverse perspectives, options and views.

You will learn:

- A deep understanding of the drivers of complexity and complex theory
- The characteristics and key sources of complexity within an engagement process
- Identify and apply a range of strategies for dealing with complex engagement, applied across a variety of spheres
- Use critical thinking in choosing and applying strategies that are purposeful, context-appropriate, responsive and iterative, and which meet the Core Values
- Design an engagement plan for your own project which describes how strategies are used and when, including a detailed risk management analysis
- Map how complexity may change across a project or an organisation over time, and consider the impacts of organization culture in continuous improvement of engagement practice
